This agreement is made on the date below by and between Kathryn Campion and William Simonson, individually, Dance North County, and Positive Action Community Theatre (PACT) and its teachers and volunteers (hereafter “PACT”), on the one hand, and the undersigned individual, or parent or guardian of the minor participant attending workshops with PACT, on the other hand.

As additional consideration for PACT to teach workshops to the participants, I, for myself and for my minor child(ren), heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, release, acquit and forever discharge PACT, Kathryn Campion, William Simonson, Dance North County, and all of PACT’s employees and volunteers, from any and all claims, actions, causes of action, demands, rights, damages, costs, loss of services, expenses and compensation whatsoever, whether known and unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, anticipated or unanticipated, which we may have or which may hereafter accrue on account of or in any way growing out of our use of PACT and its facilities on this or any other date.

It is further understood and agreed that all rights under Section 1542 of the Civil Code of the State of California and any similar law of any state or territory of the United States are hereby expressly waived. Said section reads as follows:

1542. Certain claims not affected by general release. A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in creditor’s favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him must have materially affected creditor’s settlement with the debtor.

I declare that this agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties and that the terms are contractual and not merely recitals. I am of legal age and capacity and willingly enter into this agreement and agree to be bound by them.

If any provision is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder will remain valid and enforceable. Any disputes hereunder will be interpreted in accordance with California law with venue in San Diego County.
